

機構簡介

香港青少年服務處為多元化社會服務機構, 服務包括綜合家庭服務、臨床心理服務、綜 合家居照顧服務、兒童之家、寄養服務、綜 合青少年服務中心、課餘託管、青少年中 心、學校社會工作服務、地區青少年外展社 會工作服務、深宵外展服務、濫用精神藥物 者輔導中心、復康服務、網上青年支援服務 及特別服務計劃。

服務宗旨

心弦成長中心為荃灣及葵青區人士提供預防 濫用精神科藥物教育、治療康復、及戒藥輔 導服務。中心由專業社工及醫護人員組成, 以社區為本位,運用專業社工及跨專業協作 手法,例如個案及小組輔導服務、社區資源 轉介,協助有吸食危害精神毒品習慣的人士 及處身於危機下的青少年停止濫用精神科藥 物。

中心同時協助戒藥者的家庭處理家庭成員戒藥的問題,亦會透過教育活動為服務對象提供有關精神科藥物的知識,從而提升對各類危害精神毒品的警覺性。

透過推行專業培訓及各類定期社區推廣活動,中心支援區內各持份者及專業人員,進行預防教育,共建無毒社區,並為有戒藥服務需要的青少年及社區人士重建健康社區生活,秦出扣人心弦的生命樂曲。

服務目標

- 協助吸食精神科藥物人士停止濫藥習慣及 發展健康生活模式。
- 2. 增強身處濫藥危機下人士對毒品的警覺及協助他們遠離毒品。
- 3. 主動接觸濫藥者,及早進行適時的介入工作。
- 4. 為濫藥者的家庭成員提供輔導及協助,在 處理問題時提供支援。
- 5. 為已聯繫專業人員提供訓練,促進他們為 濫用藥物者提供支援。
- 6. 在識別和介入過程中與各相關的持份者, 例如青少年服務單位、警方、學校、醫療 人員維持積極的協作。
- 7. 於社區層面提供有關預防濫用藥物的教育、 宣傳活動予中學學生及社區人士。
- 8. 鼓勵濫藥者及早求助,並通過醫療支援服 務持續參與治療療程。

服務對象

- 1. 經常濫用精神科藥物人士;
- 2. 未經醫療諮詢情況下偶有濫用精神科藥物者;
- 3. 身處危機而對濫用藥物後果欠缺警覺的潛 在濫用精神科藥物者;

Scope of Service

- 1.Treatment and rehabilitative services for PSAs comprising assessment service, matching of mode of detoxification, relapse prevention, individual and group counselling service to help them resume normal functioning;
- 2.Outreaching service to PSAs for early identification and intervention;
- 3.Counselling and support services for early dischargees and/or relapse prevention/ aftercare services for needy dischargees from self-financing residential drug treatment and rehabilitation centres (DTRCs) without such provision;
- 4.Preventive education programmes for secondary students, potenital or occasional PSAs, and for the general public at community level:
- 5. Counselling service and supportive programmes for family members of PSAs:
- 6.Expert information and advice on substance and substance abuse;
- 7. Professional training for allied professional and stakeholders who are working with habitual/ occasional/ potenial PSAs;
- 8.Medical support service for PSAs comprising body checks, drug tests, motivational interviews, and drug-related consultation in connection to the treatment and rehabilitation of the PSAs; case referrals to medical specialist treatment, Substance Abuse Clinics and/or other mode of drug treatment and rehabilitation programmes as appropriate; and
- 9. Any other services to meet the changing service demand and drug abuse scenes.

Introduction

Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency. The Agency provides social services including Integrated Family Services, Clinical Psychological Service, Integrated Home Care Services, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre, After-School Care Service, Children and Youth Centre, School Social Work Service, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service, Counselling Centre for Psychotropic Substance Abusers, Rehabilitation Service, Cyber Youth Support Service and Special Projects.

Objectives of Service

The Centre is a designated service unit providing a continuum of direct community-based non-residential drug treatment and rehabilitation services as well as preventive education services to psychotropic substance abusers (PSAs) and young people at risk. Through a team of professional social workers and medical nursing staff, the Sane Centre is serving Tsuen Wan, Kwai Chung and Tsing Yi districts on a cluster-basis with multi-level social work interventions entailing preventive, developmental, supportive and remedial functions.

The services of Sane Centre are to assist the habitual / occasional / potential PSAs and young people at risk in abstaining from abusing psychotropic substances and developing healthy lifestyle through a wide range of one-stop services like medical check-up, case work, group counseling services and referrals to community resources. The Centre endeavors to build up a supportive, caring and healthy community to the youth and service recipient by providing preventive education on awareness of psychotropic drug abuse, professional training, community publicity activities and support. The service also aims at facilitating the significant others of the PSAs, especially their family members, as well as other helping professionals / stakeholders involved in the helping process via a consonance of community organizations and collaboration.

Purpose

- 1. To help PSAs abstain from their drug-taking habits and develop a healthy lifestyle;
- 2. To increase the awareness of those vulnerable to drug abuse and to steer them away from drugs;
- 3. To reach out to PSAs for timely and early intervention;
- 4. To provide counselling and assistance to family members of PSAs so as to help them deal with the problems;
- 5. To provide professional training for allied professionals with a view to facilitating their assistance to PSAs;
- To maintain active collaboration with stakeholders concerned, e.g. young people service units, police, schools, medical practitioners etc. in the identification and intervention process for PSAs;
- To provide preventive education and publicity programs to students of secondary schools, post-secondary institutions, and vocational training organizations, and the general public at community level; and
- 8. To motivate PSAs to seek early assistance and stay with the treatment program through medical support services.

Target Group of Service

- Habitual PSAs who have developed physical and/or psychological dependence on drugs;
- 2. Occasional PSAs who use psychotropic substance for various reasons without medical consultation:
- Potential PSAs who are in high risk environment/ situation and/or ignorant of the risks and consequences of such abuse:
- Dischargees form self-financing DTRCs in need, of professional support and aftercare service in the community;
- 5. significant others of PSAs, such as parents, families, school personnel and employers, etc;
- Allied professionals who are working with potential, occasional or habitual PSAs:and
- 7. Stakeholders and general public, especially young people, at community level.
