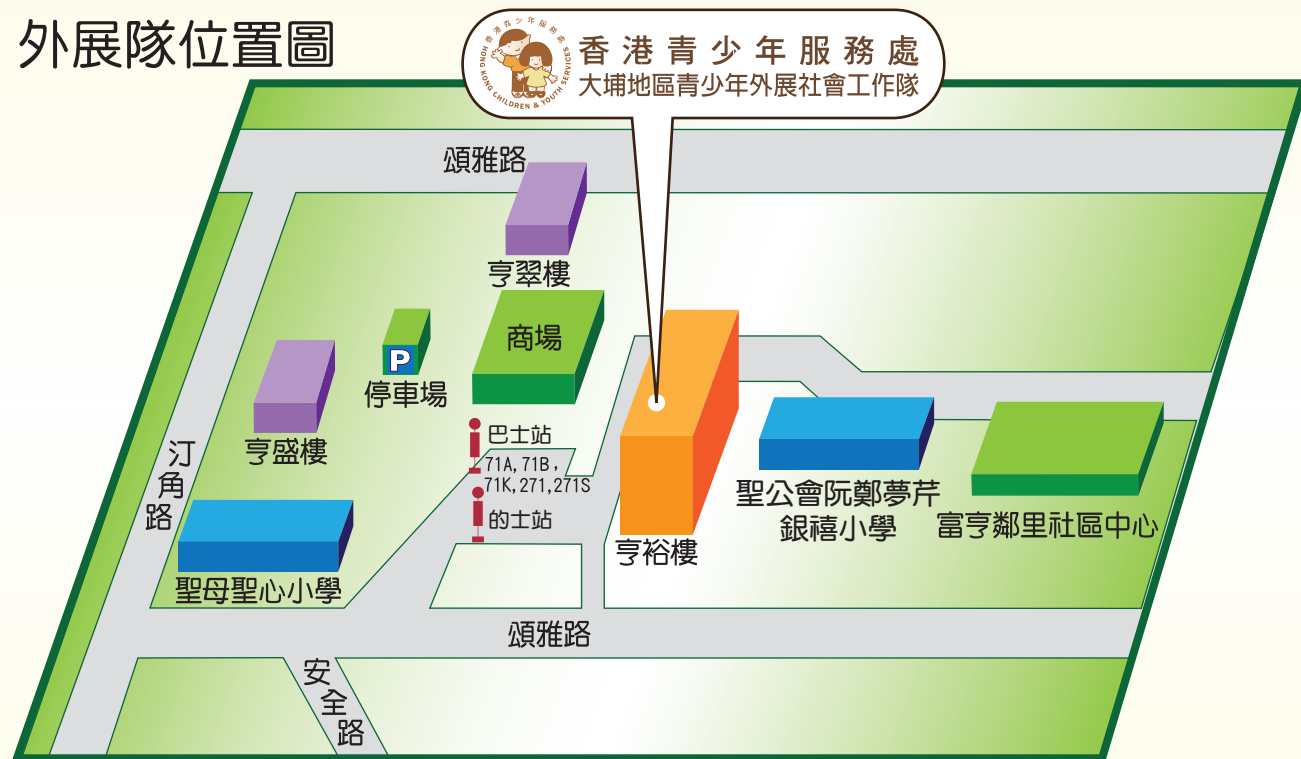

大埔地區青少年外展社會工作隊 服務簡介



機構簡介

香港青少年服務處為多元化社會服務機構，服務包括綜合家庭服務、臨床心理服務、綜合家居照顧服務、兒童之家、寄養服務、綜合青少年服務中心、課餘託管、青少年中心、學校社會工作服務、地區青少年外展社會工作服務、深宵外展服務及濫用精神藥物者輔導中心。

服務宗旨及目標

外展社會工作隊旨在主動辨識及外展接觸青少年服務對象，協助他們解決問題及所遇到之困難、發展潛能、預防及避免接觸不良影響，並融入社群。

具體目標如下：

- 1.及早辨識和外展接觸青少年服務對象，預防他們行為上進一步偏差或接觸不良負面元素；
- 2.提供指導與支援，以引導青少年服務對象至正面的生活方式；
- 3.提高青少年服務對象解決困難及問題的能力；
- 4.培育青少年服務對象的正面社會價值觀和態度，並提升其社會功能和個人潛能。

服務對象

外展社會工作服務的主要服務對象為年齡介乎6至24歲的大埔區青少年，他們通常不參加傳統活動或容易接觸不良影響，引致出現越軌行為等問題。

服務性質

外展社工會到青少年經常聚集的地方如網吧、遊樂場、遊戲機中心、桌球室等，作有系統的觀察，主動認識服務對象，評估其需要。

服務包括：

- 1.主動辨識及接觸潛在青少年服務對象；
- 2.與服務對象以個別或小組形式直接接觸；
- 3.不論以個人或組群形式，提供指導與輔導，協助青少年服務對象克服困難或問題；
- 4.舉辦小組活動或計劃，從而建立關係、提供指導、技能訓練、教育、加強對毒品禍害的醒覺、社區服務、餘閒活動或其他特定目標的服務，以達至個案工作計劃；
- 5.按青少年服務對象的需要，提供適切的轉介服務，包括濫用精神藥物者輔導中心，以滿足服務需要。

雖然服務性質以外展工作為主，服務使用者亦可於服務單位或以外的地方向社工直接尋求協助。

- 1.本處外展社工會主動認識在服務範圍內經常流連和聚集的青少年；經過評估手續後，社工便會開展有目標的介入工作，他們便會成為本處的服務對象。
- 2.本處亦歡迎青少年和有關人士，直接向外展社工求助或作出轉介，經過評估手續後，如有服務需要，他們也會成為本處的服務對象。倘若外展服務並不符合求助人或轉介者的需要，社工則會向他們陳明未能提供服務的原因，並盡量向其提供有關其他合適服務的資料。
- 3.服務對象如欲退出服務，可與負責社工提出終止服務要求，以便作出安排。

服務費用

視乎個別活動程序而定，輔導服務不會收取費用。

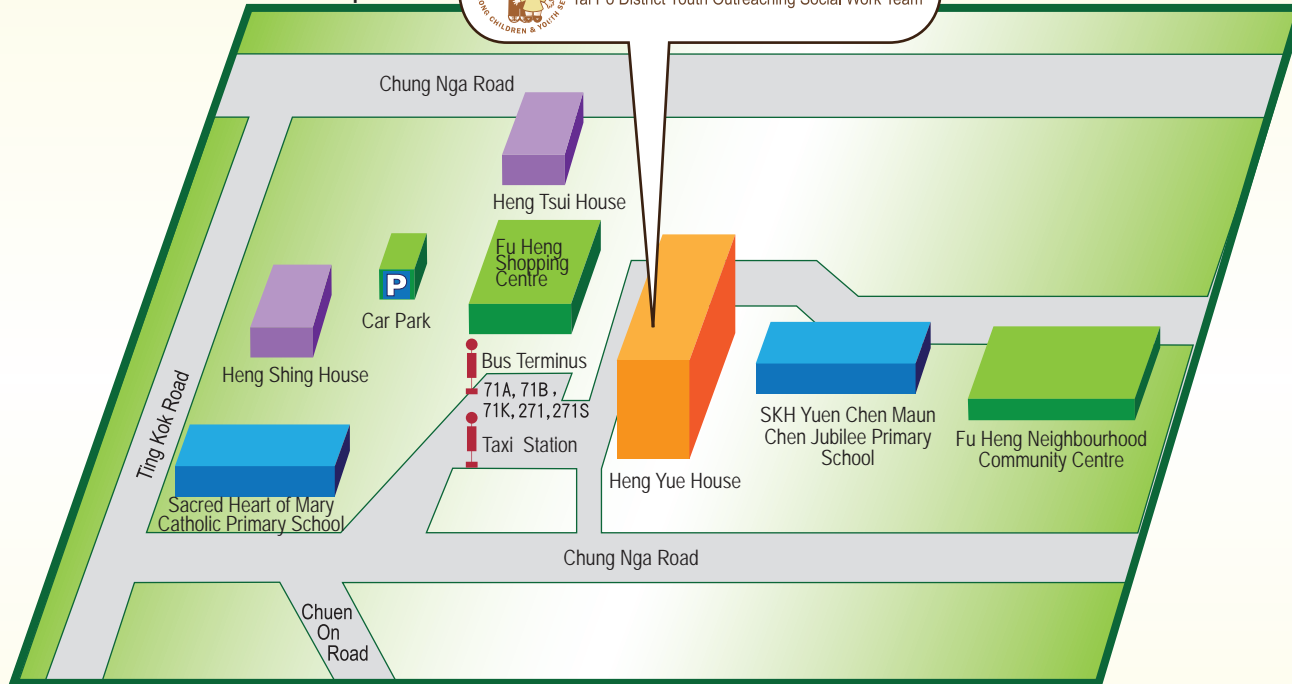

Introduction

Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency. The Agency provides social services including Integrated Family Services, Clinical Psychological Service, Integrated Home Care Services, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre, After-School Care Service, Children and Youth Centre, School Social Work Service, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service and Counselling Centre for Psychotropic Substance Abusers.

Purpose and Objectives of Service

The purpose of District Youth Outreaching Social Work is to identify and engage target clients to help them to overcome their problems and difficulties, develop their potential and become socially integrated.

The Specific objectives are:

- 1.To early identify and reach out to the target service users and prevent them from further behavioural deterioration and falling prey to negative elements;
- 2.To provide guidance/support to direct the target service users to more positive lifestyles;
- 3.To empower the target service users to overcome their difficulties and problems; and
- 4.To foster the development of positive social values and attitudes as well as to enhance their social functioning and potentials of the target service users.

Target Group of Service

Target service users are young people aged 6 to 24, who do not normally participate in conventional social or youth activities and vulnerable or exposed to undesirable influence and /or manifesting behavioural problems within Tai Po District

Nature of Service

Our Outreaching Social workers will actively reach out to different youth gathering places such as internet café, playground, video game centers, billiard rooms , etc. for systematic observation and assess their service need through direct contact.

The Services to be provided include:

1. Identifying and targeting potential clients;
2. Establishing direct contacts with targets, either individually or in group;
3. Providing counselling, either on an individual or group basis, to assist clients to overcome their difficulties or problem;
4. Organising group activities or programs for guidance, skill training, education, drugs awareness, community service, recreation, rapport building or other specified purposes in order to achieve case plans; and
5. Referring clients to other appropriate services such as counselling centres for Psychotropic Substance Abusers in order to meet their needs.

While the service is outreaching in nature, service users may approach the service directly for assistance, either in or out of office/working base.

Procedures of Application and Withdrawal

1. Our Outreaching Social Workers will actively reach out to and establish direct contact with young people at their gathering places within the service boundary. A purposeful intervention plan will be provided with their needs and problems are assessed. The individuals will then be registered as our service user.
2. Children, youth and relevant individuals are welcome to seek help directly from Outreaching Social Workers or through referral. They can be admitted as our service users if they fulfil the criteria of assessment. If Outreaching Social Service is found not suitable to the needs of the applicant/ the referred individual, worker will inform him / her the reason of being refused, and where appropriate, refer him / her to other relevant alternative services.
3. Withdrawal request can be forwarded to the responsible Social Worker for further arrangement.

Charges of Service

Service charges vary in accordance with the nature of programmes and activities. Counselling Service is free of charge.
