Introduction

Hong Kong Children & Youth Services is a multi-social service agency. The Agency provides social services including Integrated Family Services, Clinical Psychological Service, Integrated Home Care Services, Small Group Homes, Foster Care Service, Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre, After-School Care Service, Children and Youth Centre, School Social Work Service, District Youth Outreaching Social Work Service, Overnight Outreaching Service, Counselling Centre for Psychotropic Substances Abusers and Special Service Projects.

Purpose and Objectives of Service

The aim of Integrated Children & Youth Services Centre is to assist children and young people to become happy, mature, responsible and contributing members of society by means of participation and experience. The specific objectives of centre are:

1. To facilitate personal development of children and youth by assisting them for better self-understanding, emotional handling, to develop their problem solving and stress management capacity and to explore their potential.
2. To assist children and youth to acquire positive social values, and to establish harmonious interpersonal and family relationship.
3. To enable the development of social consciousness among children and youth to contribute to the well being of the community.
4. To provide support and guidance for those children and young people who are deprived from social resources or living in an unfavorable environment.
5. To closely collaborate with the community so as to provide a supportive environment for the growth and development of children and young people.

Target Group of Service

Centre provides service to children and young people between the ages of 6 to 24 and their families in North district.

Scope of Service

By means of Centre service, school social work service and outreaching social work service, the following four core services are provided through case work approach, group and community activities according to community needs.

1. Guidance and counselling
2. Supportive Programmes
3. Developmental & Socialization Programmes
4. Community Engagement Programmes

Varieties of supportive programmes including recreational activities, interest classes/groups, study/reading room facilities are also provided.

Service will also be rendered during non-office hour whenever needs arise.

Procedures of Application and Withdrawal

1. Enrollment can be made in person to centre and school social work office. Phone and postal application will also be accepted.
2. Children and young people will also be accepted as our service user when identified by social workers at the gathering places within the service boundary.
3. Children and young people between the ages of 6 and 24 are eligible for centre member. His/her family members are eligible for centre's affiliated members.
4. Single-parent families, CSSA recipients, new arrivals for staying in Hong Kong less than 3 years or clients referral by social workers can apply for the remission of membership fee.
5. Service users can make a request to the responsible social worker if he/she intends to withdraw from our services or activities. The request will be handled on an individual basis.

Charges of Service

Membership charges subject to annual adjustment in April. Programme fees vary in accordance with the nature of the activity. Single-parent families, CSSA recipients, new arrivals for less than 3 years and referral from social workers can apply remission for membership and programme charges.
