

Occupational Therapy Service

What is Occupational Therapy?

- To provide tailored assessments and trainings for children with learning difficulties, developmental delay, gross motor or fine motor delay in order to improve children's learning ability, fine motor development and self-care ability.
- Trainings consist of sensory integration, fine motor, visual perception, attention, executive function, prewriting, handwriting, self-care and activity of daily life.

Objectives

- To provide early identification and intervention for children with special educational needs by delivering tailored trainings and to increase the therapeutic effectiveness.
- To promote the development of the children's sensory integration, gross motor, fine motor, and visual perception, and thus enhance their handwriting and self-care ability.
- To relieve the children's emotional stress induced by learning difficulties and developmental delay, and to help them building up positive self-image.

Service Targets

- Children and teenagers who are suspected of or diagnosed with learning difficulties, developmental delay, sensory integration disorder, gross motor or fine motor delay.
 (For example, autism spectrum disorder, ADHD and developmental coordination disorder)
- Parents of the above-mentioned children and teenagers
